

Research Study on Relationships After Cancer:

OSU Research Team Looking for New Study Participants

If you participate in this study:

- 1. You and your partner will learn coping and communication skills that can improve your health and relationship after cancer.
- 2. Couples will be randomly assigned to participate in one of two skill-building programs. Programs will be delivered online via Zoom.

Program #1

- Couples will participate in 5 weekly sessions.
- Couples will learn ways to improve their personal and relationship health, focusing on coping with changes in intimacy and family building plans.

Program #2

- Couples will participate in 4 weekly sessions.
- Couples will learn ways to improve their personal and relationship health, focusing on coping with changes in relationships after cancer.
